According to the Historic 1699 Winslow House web site, "The Isaac Winslow House was built circa 1699 for the Hon. Isaac Winslow (1671-1738) at the place named "Careswell" after their family home, "Kerswell" in Worcestershire, England. This was the third house built on land granted to Governor Edward Winslow (1595-1655) in the 1630s who erected the first homestead."
